Dear Parents/ Carers

Further to updates from Public Health England, students who have either a fever or a new cough are required to self-isolate for 7 days. Please email enquiries@hayleacademy.net or call our absence line on 01736 753009 in the usual way, to let us know if your child has these symptoms and is self-isolating so we can monitor the situation closely. Obviously students needing to self-isolate should not meet up with other students during the evening or at the weekend in order to protect other members of the school community from potential infection. Parents with concerns about their child's health should contact NHS online for advice

Teachers will set work for students who are self-isolating via SMHW and ask that children complete the set work if they are well enough to do so.

We will contact parents with more information about any changes to planned school trips as soon as we are able to.

At the current time we have no confirmed cases of Coronavirus in our school community: 1 member of staff and a small number of students are self-isolating.
