Homework Review – Your Feedback

As part of our commitment to ensuring that all of our students achieve their potential, Hayle Academy believes that every student should have the opportunity to benefit from high-quality, regular homework as an important and integral part of their learning.

We know that regularly completed homework will have a significant impact on improving students' understanding and achievement and helps students to identify their next steps in learning. From reviewing our students' GCSE success over the last two years, we can see that the students who complete their homework make more progress and achieve a greater number of qualifications at Grade 5 and above. Our Homework Policy provides regular practice for students in planning and organising their time and promotes their individual responsibility for learning.

With this in mind, we are reviewing our Homework Policy and we would like to invite your feedback as part of this consultation process. We are also gathering feedback from students and staff. We would value your input into our review, so that we are able to redesign and implement a highly effective and sustainable homework model to meet the needs of all students in every year group.

The review is considering a number of key areas, including:

- The amount of homework which is set for students in each year group.
- The type of tasks set.
- The frequency of homework.
- Which subjects should set homework?
- How to best share what has been set with parents, including deadlines for submission.
