Dear Parents/Carers

Amidst much speculation in the media and leaked information regarding arrangements for schools in the Autumn, I would like to reassure our parents that we are very carefully planning for our full re-opening in September.

Throughout recent months, we have prioritised the safety of our students, staff and community and fully complied with the guidance from the Government and Public Health England. This will continue to be our approach as we plan for full re-opening from September, in partnership with our secondary partner schools and with the full support of our Governors.

Many parents will be aware of the emerging proposals for 'year group' social bubbles. We anticipate detailed guidance will be provided by the Government later this week, and that we will therefore be able to provide full details of our re-opening plans by the end of term. Please be assured that we will work in close partnership with parents to support students to return to school as confident, enthusiastic learners: where needed, support will be provided on an individual basis for students where this transition back to school is potentially more challenging or complex for them.

We know that the sweeping changes that Covid 19 has brought have impacted on many of our families and on our community. Whilst these continue to be worrying times for us all, the return to 'full time' school in September should be a joyful event and one which brings highly valued educational and social opportunities for our children. We are very much looking forward to welcoming students back and to providing the stability and routine (albeit altered and adapted) that comes with school life and we will be sharing our detailed plans with our families as soon as possible.
