

Home School Partnership Agreement – COVID 19 Supplement

As a parent or carer, I agree to:

- Only send my child to school if I am confident that they are fully fit and well
- Keep my child at home if I am less certain about their health, telephoning the school to discuss such concerns in the first instance before sending them in
- Ensure that my child's hands are washed before they leave for school
- Ensure that I have given the school a contact telephone number that can be accessed at any time by the school during the school day in the event I am required to collect my child
- Ensure that I collect my child, if required, as soon as possible
- Ensure that I communicate with the school over any absence my child has, on the first day they are unable to attend school
- Inform the school of any COVID 19 illness, or suspected COVID 19 illness, in the family home that requires a period of self-isolation
- Follow Public Health England requirements for self-isolation in the event my child, or a member of the family, has a suspected or confirmed case of Covid 19
- Where possible, engage in health testing for my child should they have symptoms of Covid -19
- Ensure that my child understands the importance of, and follows, the social distancing measures in place in school including on their way to and from school
- Support the school to respond to any intentional breach of social distancing measures by my child, understanding the high level of importance associated with these measures which provide for the safety of the school community

As a school, we agree to:

- Promote and provide for social distancing and good hygiene routines as far as we are able to
- Provide PPE to our staff so that they can protect your child when they require medical support
- Provide a system which limits the number of contacts between your child and other students (and staff) as far as possible
- Work closely with you to share any concerns about your child's health and wellbeing should these arise

Together, we agree to:

- Behave positively towards one another, even in difficult or worrying situations
- Work in partnership to support educational progress and student wellbeing
- Communicate positively with each other should a problem or issue arise and seek to resolve it together

Home School Partnership Agreement: Support Programme for Year 10

I would like my child to attend the school's on-site support programme from the week beginning Monday 22nd June 2020.

I have read and understood the information provided by the school with regards to social distancing, tutorials and hygiene.
