Dear Parents / Carers

Thank you for confirming that your child will be with us over coming days as part of the Government's requirements for schools to provide supervision for children of key workers, and for vulnerable children.

We have a planned programme of activities in place. Your child should come into school through the main doors and use the available hand gel on arrival. Parents dropping students off should not enter the school site and should use the car park at the front of the school, by the main entrance. Students are asked to wait in Reception to be collected by staff. They should not access any area of the school site without supervision and must maintain social distancing with other children and staff at all times: a minimum of 2m. We will do our very best to maintain these social distancing arrangements throughout the day but cannot guarantee this will be possible.

At this time, any student who does not engage in the activities or who does not follow the instructions given by teacher will not be able to continue to attend provision on site. It is essential that all students are respectful towards each other and towards the staff providing their care and supervision. Should students not follow these expectations, parents will be contacted and the student will be removed from the provision.

To collect your child, parents are asked to text their child to let them know they have arrived. Please do not enter the school building. Your child will be brought to the car park at the front of school by a member of staff.

Food will be available at lunchtime or your child can bring their own packed lunch and snacks to school. Please do not give children sweets, fizzy drinks or chewing gum to bring into school. Children may wear their own clothes, providing these are suitable for school. Trainers and comfortable casual clothes are the best choice, suitable for active lessons where available in the afternoon e.g. leggings, jeans. Facial piercings and dangling earrings should not be worn and the school's usual expectations around make up and hair styles remain the same. As general guidance, clothes suitable for a 'non school uniform day' will be fine.

Your support in ensuring your child understands these expectations before arrival on site tomorrow is very much appreciated.
