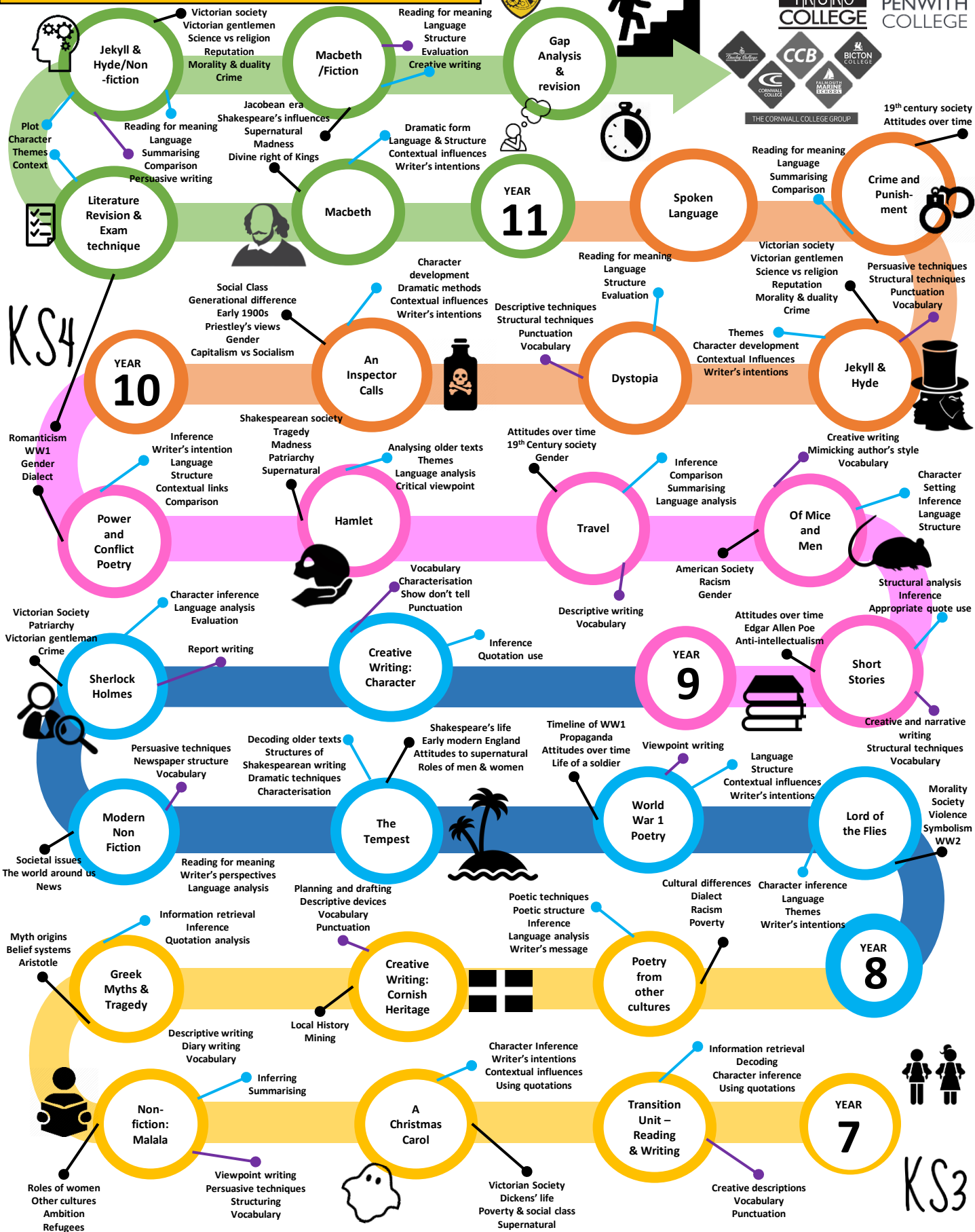


# English at Hayle Academy
