Dear Parent/Carer

Thank you for your support following the launch of the revised home learning curriculum and timetable. Please find attached the next two-week timetable as an overview of the home learning planned to support your child **from Monday 11<sup>th</sup> May to Friday 22<sup>nd</sup> May**.

Work will continue to be set using Show My Homework in line with the timetable. All session activities will be published on the timetabled day with the date in its heading, to help our students to manage and structure their work with a 24 hour deadline for submission – except for Year 10 option subjects, which will be published across the week. One of the reasons for this is to avoid a build-up of tasks on Show My Homework and to help to provide greater clarity and structure for our students.

You can follow the timetable and suggested timings or may prefer to change things to make the learning fit your own situation. Everyone has their unique context and we are aware that during this time of challenge we are all trying to make things work for our own families. Therefore, if a student submits their work past the submission deadline but within the two-week period, this will not be penalised; this is a two-week timetable, so students can submit their work in that time frame.

It would be useful if you can make sure your child uses their own account for 'Show My Homework' and that your child submits their work via this platform, so that they can receive regular teacher feedback.
