Year 6 Open Day – Thursday 21st September 2023

Dear Parents and Carers,

As part of our transition programme, Hayle Academy is providing an Open Day for Year 6 students from our local primary schools. This will provide the opportunity for them to experience a day in the life of Hayle Academy.

Therefore, **students in Year 8 and in Year 9 will be learning from home on Thursday 21st September.** They are expected to complete their home learning for their timetabled lessons that day; this will be set via our Class Charts platform.

Students are expected to join a morning tutor time Google Meet at 08:50 – 09:00. A register of attendance will be taken 'live' and their tutor will provide further details to your child on how to access the Google Meet through their tutor time Google Classroom next week.

Our Year 8 and 9 students are of an age when they should largely be able to manage their learning through our online learning. Students who need support during the day can contact their teachers, tutors and our pastoral and safeguarding teams via their emails. In addition, a Google Classroom will be available to support students during the day – a member of staff will be on hand to answer any questions or to provide any further support with the home learning 'live' during the timetabled lesson.

Year 8 and Year 9 students are expected in school on Friday 22nd September by 08:50 as normal.
