As we near the end of Men's Health Awareness Month, we are pleased to be hosting Andrew Bernard to lead a series of supportive workshops in school on Tuesday 5th December. He has delivered more than 2,000 workshops and talks internationally, worked with 165,000 people, is a Fellow of the Professional Speaking Association, TEDx Speaker and entrepreneur.

He will be delivering workshops to all students in Years 9 & 10 throughout the day, an overview of these can be found below:

What Makes A (Hu)Man is a programme for young people to help young people consider relationships, modern manhood, think about unhelpful masculinity, equality and develop empathy, character, and integrity.

What Makes A (Hu)Man will consider attitude, choices and responsibility, and the power and agency that young people have over themselves and their futures. It addresses the difficulties faced when we are subject to peer pressure and the pull of whatever is deemed to be the social norm at any given time.

The workshop will include discussion around approaches to relationships that include unhealthy behaviours, and open up opportunities where empathy can be grown. Students will develop a greater understanding of roles within society, and strategies to support their self-esteem and character.
