## **Term Dates 2024-25**

Looking ahead to the next academic year **2024-2025** and in light of previous feedback from families, I thought that this would be a useful time to share the term dates and staff training days in advance.

- Two training days at the start of the Autumn term: Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> and Tuesday 3<sup>rd</sup> September 2024. Therefore, students will return from Wednesday 4<sup>th</sup> September. This will be a staggered return with Year 7 and 11 on the 4<sup>th</sup> and all years from the 5<sup>th</sup> onwards.
- Training days on the Thursday 19<sup>th</sup> September 2024 and Monday 4<sup>th</sup> November 2024.
- Two January training days, one of which will be a joint secondary conference across the Trust: Monday 6<sup>th</sup> and Tuesday 7<sup>th</sup> January 2025. Therefore, students will start the Spring 2024 term on the Wednesday 8<sup>th</sup> January 2025 onwards.
- The last day of the summer term for students will be Monday 21st July 2025.
