

Truro and Penwith Application Process for Learners with EHCPs

Student applies and declares they have an EHCP.

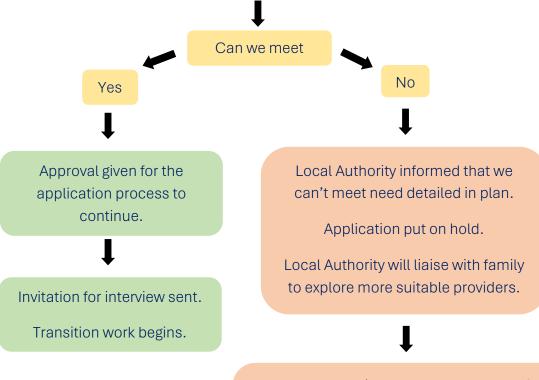


Application is sent to Learning Support for approval.



Learning Support will contact the local authority for a copy of the EHCP and other statutory paperwork so we can determine whether we can meet need and identify level of support needed.

Learning Support may also contact you, your current provider (if applicable), and any other professionals detailed in your EHCP e.g. CAMHS, Visual Support Team, Autism Team etc.



Please note – if you do not feel the EHCP accurately reflects current need you may wish to ask your current provider or caseworker for an interim EHCP review to amend the plan at which point college might be reconsulted.

If you wish to explore or progress to Truro and Penwith College, please inform your Casework Officer at your Local Authority as soon as possible. If you do not know who this is, you can contact statutorysen@cornwall.gov.uk.

The deadline for us to be consulted by the Local Authority is March 31st each year.

Please note – initial conversations do not constitute an offer of a place at college. Where college have confirmed that needs in the EHCP can be met. All learners must attend interview and meet the entry requirements for their chosen course.
