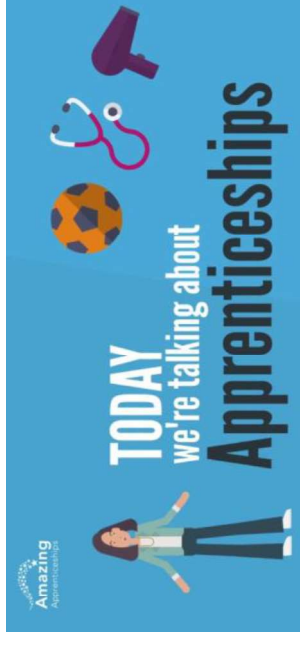

Careers Advice: How to find an Apprenticeship

1. Search regularly for Apprenticeship opportunities with companies. Just like with a job, these need to be applied for and there will be an interview process. Sometimes they use an assessment centre, which includes a range of tasks to demonstrate your skills. 2. The speculative search – contact local companies for the industry you are interested in and ask if they have an apprenticeship scheme or if they would consider taking on an apprentice.
