I am writing to invite you to Cornwall School of Mathematics and Science (CSMS) Open Evening which is taking place on **Thursday 20**th **November from 6pm** with a presentation from the Head of CSMS Vicky Holland-Lloyd at **6:15pm**. If your son / daughter is aspiring to study Maths or Science for their A levels, then CSMS provides a truly exceptional programme of study, alongside specialist co-curricular opportunities that help to prepare students for progression to the very top universities.

I am also pleased to be able to invite you to our Open Evening for Cornwall School of Liberal Arts (CSLA). This unique programme was launched in 2022 following the success of CSMS, and to support our more able students who wish to study Liberal Arts subjects at A level and beyond. The evening is also taking place on **Thursday 20**th **November from 6pm** with a presentation at **7pm** by the Head of CSLA Dr Cate McGovern.

Both programmes are the natural progression for ambitious learners, who will be encouraged to reach their potential alongside opportunities such as academic research, an outstanding international programme, and a programme of lectures and seminars showcasing current research. The Liberal Arts, Law, Veterinary, Medical and Oxbridge specialist pathways provide students with specific preparation towards a strong university application. Students also have the flexibility to combine their A Levels with many other subjects at Camborne Sixth Form.

The success of our approach is evident in our results. In summer 2025, our students achieved an outstanding 71% A*-A grades, which is more than double the national average of 28%. Crucially, this success led to 7 successful applications to Oxford and Cambridge universities.

The Open Evening will offer parents, carers and students the opportunity to find out more about the programmes and meet current staff and students.
