Last day of term

As a reminder to all parents and carers, our term ends for students on **Friday 19th December**. Students can wear non-school uniform on this day, although please ensure that all clothing is appropriate for school. For example, crop-style tops are not permitted.

We will follow our traditional end-of-term schedule with a slightly shorter day for students. All students will enjoy lunch and a final farewell with their tutor group before leaving school at 13:05. The day will begin with celebratory House assemblies, recognising positive engagement in school and learning throughout the term.

However, **if your child accesses the county bus or taxi transport service**, these buses/ taxis are unable to collect at an earlier time and will remain available at 15:15. If your child remains on site, they will remain supervised in an IT room until the end of the day.

The survey link will close at midday on Tuesday 16th December; thank you in advance for completing this link if your child accesses county transport. Please note, if your child accesses the school's own transport, the mini bus will transport students home at the earlier time of 13:05.

January 2026 return to school

Just a reminder that we look forward to welcoming students back to school after the Christmas break on **Tuesday 6th January 2026** at the normal time. Students will return on Week B of their timetable.

The after school Hayle Xtra clubs for the Spring term will commence from Monday 12th January 2026.

The first Broad Horizons Spring session will start on the afternoon of Thursday 15th January and fortnightly from that point.

Equipment and Uniform

Please ensure your child brings the correct equipment to school each day, including their school iPad charged to at least 80% and a stylus. Students who receive Free School Meals have been provided with a stylus, and it is their responsibility to bring this daily to support their learning. We highly recommend that all students use a stylus as part of their equipment list, as it improves precision when completing tasks and enhances the quality of digital work.

Home Learning

We are really impressed with the excellent weekly uptake of Sparx Maths home learning – well done to all our students for their commitment and consistency.

Excitingly, we are looking forward to sharing some upcoming developments in our home learning approach, focused on prioritising student knowledge and recall alongside high-quality regular reading. With this in mind, we will soon be introducing Sparx Science and Sparx Reader, which will replace the current daily KS3 home reading programme following student feedback. Further details will be shared with parents and students at the earliest opportunity.

Year 11: Period 5

From early January, we will be introducing **Period 5** for all Year 11 students as part of our Spring term support in preparation for public examinations. These additional sessions will provide focused time with subject specialists to strengthen knowledge and skills. The timetable will prioritise **English, Maths, Science**, and subjects with coursework or controlled assessment elements. Each student is expected to attend on **Monday, Tuesday, and Thursday from 15:15 to 16:00. Friday** will be reserved for subjects with coursework or controlled assessments nearing deadlines, so attendance will depend on individual option choices.

This approach is in line with most schools regionally and nationally and reflects our strong commitment to supporting your child as they prepare for their Spring mock exams and final GCSE examinations. Further details will be shared by Mr Radford in the coming weeks and please do contact your child's Year 11 tutor if you would like to discuss any further support.
